
How to find a Graduate Program in Nutrition

Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN)



Coordinated Programs in Dietetics
Bachelor's and graduate level —
dietitian coursework and supervised
practice for RDN eligibility (combined
program)

OR



<u>Didactic Programs in Dietetics</u>
Bachelor's and graduate level - dietitian coursework only (must be completed before the Dietetic Internship required for RDN eligibility)

PLUS

Dietetic Internships



Post bachelor's — supervised practice only for RDN eligibility (must complete DPD and at least a bachelor's degree before entry)

Nutrition and Dietetic Technicians, Registered (NDTR)



Nutrition and Dietetic Technician Programs

Associate's degree — DT coursework and supervised practice for NDTR eligibility

Clicking into each section will pull up a search. Coordinated Programs combine your dietetic internship with your ACEND program. If you do not do a coordinated program you will need to do a program and an internship separately.

You can search programs more specifically by using the filters provided. Try searching in both the Coordinated Programs and the Didactic Programs to find what you are looking for.
