Master of Accountancy (MACC)

The Master of Accountancy program provides greater breadth and depth to further develop the knowledge and skills needed to enter professional accountancy. With nearly a 100 percent placement rate, MACC graduates have opportunities to work for accounting firms or government agencies across the U.S. and around the world. Typical jobs include positions in taxation, auditing, and controller-ship.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. MACC application + \$60 (USD) fee
2. Bachelor's degree from accredited university, demonstrated by official transcript of all coursework after high school, with a 3.0 GPA or higher
3. Course syllabi of required foundation courses
4. Acceptance to the program requires an Admission Index Score of 1400. $\text{Index} = (\text{GPA} \times 200) + (\text{GMAT} \times 1.5)$ GRE scores are converted to a GMAT equivalent using this tool.
5. Students from AACSB accredited schools may be eligible for a GMAT/GRE waiver based on GPA or work experience.
6. Submit a professional resume
7. Submit a one-page letter describing your goals.
8. Proof of English proficiency, finances and passport
