Vernal, Utah

Vernal, also known as “Dinosaurland”, is the county seat and largest city in Uintah County. It is located about 175 miles east of Salt Lake City and 20 miles west of the Colorado border. Vernal is bordered on the north by the Uinta Mountains, with the Book Cliffs to the south and Blue Mountain to the east. Vernal itself lies in Ashley Valley, named in honor of William H. Ashley, an early fur trader who entered the area in 1825 by floating down the Green River in a bull boat made of animal hides.
