

WHAT IS AN EMERGENCY WITHDRAWAL FOR?

SUU recognizes that students may experience unique emergency circumstances that significantly impact their academic work. The emergency withdrawal process offers such students an opportunity to petition for a refund of a portion of their tuition and fees and/or change in academic record.

EMERGENCY WITHDRAWALS ARE FOR:



Students whose emergency circumstance is **unforeseen, out of their control**, and making it **impossible** to complete course work.



Students who can provide supporting documentation including dates that verify when the circumstance took place.



Students seeking an emergency withdrawal from an individual course who can justify why the circumstance is only affecting that particular course.

Example: Student breaks their leg and can longer participate in their Pickleball course.

EMERGENCY WITHDRAWALS ARE NOT FOR:



Cleaning up academic records.



Getting out of paying a remaining balance.



A last resort to salvage a student's GPA or financial aid eligibility.



Trying to withdraw or drop a class after missing a withdrawal deadline.
